

MINDEN WILD WATER PRESERVE (MWW)

During the Pan Am Games, temporary traffic changes will be in place near the Minden Wild Water Preserve. Plans are subject to change, so be sure to visit ontario.ca/games2015 regularly for the latest information.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

Heavier than usual traffic should be expected on the competition days, July 18 and 19. There will also be preparatory work at the venue beginning July 13.

Temporary traffic changes in the area from July 13 – 19.

- Horseshoe Lake Rd. will be closed from #1825 to north of the boat launch on July 18 and 19
- Bethel Road will be closed from Duck Lake Rd. to Horseshoe Lake Rd. on July 18 and 19.
- There will be no stopping permitted on:
 - Horseshoe Lake Rd., north of Shanahan Trail
 - Horseshoe Lake Rd., south of Sapling Rd.
 - Bethel Rd., east of Duck Lake Rd.
- Beginning July 13, no parking permitted:
 - Horseshoe Lake Rd, from #1825 to north of the boat launch
 - Bethel Rd., from Duck Lake Rd. to Horseshoe Lake Rd.

ADVICE FOR SPECTATORS

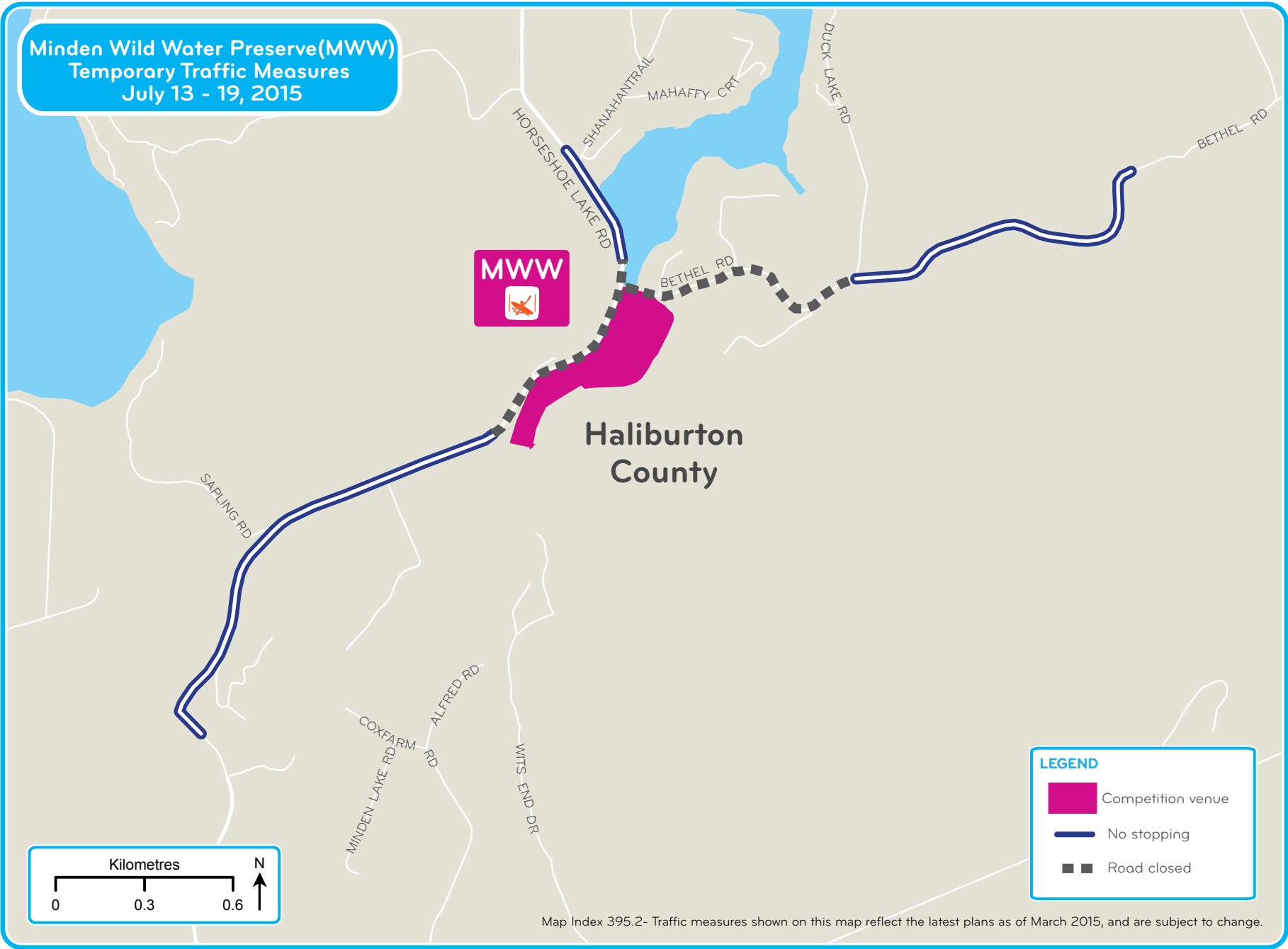
- This venue is not accessible by public transit.
- Venue parking will be available at SG Nesbitt Memorial Arena (55 Parkside Street, Minden), and a shuttle will transport spectators from the parking lot to the venue. The shuttle will be accessible.
- All spectator access will be via the S.G. Nesbitt Arena. There is no direct walk-up access to the preserve.
- Pre-booked accessible parking spaces will be available.
